





About the Survey

- The survey also ask explored if there is a interest from students to change the current declining balance meal plan to an All-You-Care- to Eat model








Frequency of meals purchased






Overall Evaluation of Each Dining Hall


Overall Evaluation of Bishop Mountain Dining Hall
















Mandatory Residential Meal Plan




